SECURITY & SAFETY TRAINING (FOUNDATION), DECEMBER 2021 **ORGANISED BY PPK MALAYSIA**

In view of the current health safety scenario in Malaysia, PPKM will be offering our security and safety training programme next month where we will address current pertinent issues in shopping malls. The programme is focused on shopping mall operations and the importance of effectively trained security personnel as they are the front-liners in our malls, especially as they are now required to be gatekeepers to control the entry of all shoppers. Our training dates are as follows:

Dates: Wed 1 Dec and Thurs 2 Dec 2021

Time: 8.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. daily

Venue: Level 5, Cititel Hotel, Mid Valley City, Lingkaran Syed Putra, 59200 Kuala Lumpur

The 2-day training sessions, conducted annually since 2006, will equip security and safety personnel from guard/officer/supervisor/executive levels in the basic procedures and knowledge required for the daily operations of shopping malls. Our trainers are sourced from senior in-house security personnel of prominent member malls with extensive working experience both in shopping malls and previously in the police force, as well as specialists from the industry.

It is our goal that all security and safety personnel are adequately trained and equipped with the basic knowledge for shopping mall operations. The seminar fees (inclusive of service tax) will be as follows:

Kindly note that the following SOPs will apply:

- Registrations for the above courses will only be accepted for fully vaccinated individuals who will be required to show their digital vaccination certificate on their MySejahtera app to verify their full vaccination status and all participants (including speakers & crew) must also be fully vaccinated individuals
- Upon participants' arrival on Day 1, we will supply one (1) covid-19 rapid antigen self-test kit per person and participants will need to carry out their own COVID-19 RAPID ANTIGEN SELF TEST. The results should be displayed approximately 15 minutes after initiating the said test and they will need to show same to the organisers immediately before being allowed to join the training.

- In the event the self-test indicates participants are positive, they will be asked to leave immediately and refer to the health authorities for appropriate action
- Admittance to our seminars will be limited only to participants who are 'low risk' and 'casual contact, no symptoms'
- The use of the MySejahtera app is mandatory for participants to check-in, with temperatures of below 37.5°C
- Hand sanitisers must be used upon entry to the premises / masks must be worn correctly at all times during the seminar, except when eating and drinking / participants to maintain a physical distance of minimum 1m at all times
- In the event all/any of the above are not complied with and/or participants develop any symptoms, we reserve the right to refuse entry and/or they will be asked to leave immediately
- We will reconfirm registrations as soon as possible on a first-come-first served basis as the classroom size is subject to SOP requirements, but it is estimated that each class will be between 20-40pax. At the same time, we reserve the right to re-schedule any classes which do not meet the minimum requirements by the venue provider.

We look forward to your close participation to ensure that your security and operations personnel are both effectively trained and kept updated so that shopping mall remain safe places for all patrons, and hope to receive your close support.
